Wan'an No. 41 Air Raid Drill

The 2018 Wan'an No. 41 Air Raid Drill will take place between 1:30 PM to 2 PM on Monday, June 4, 2018.

Notice

- 1. Once the air raid sirens go off, pedestrians and vehicles should follow evacuation instructions of police, military, and civil defense officers to seek shelter and vacate the roads. The high speed rail, railway, metro, freeway and aircraft services will operate normally, but disembarked passengers and their pickup parties should follow the evacuation instructions given by the above-mentioned personnel.
- 2. A text message will be sent to your cellphone to notify you of the beginning of the air defense drill on 1:30 PM on the day when the drill is held. Please comply with the instructions of military police, police officers and civil defense officers, and take refuge in nearby air raid shelters. A text message will be sent out to announce the end of the drill at 2 PM.
- 3. Violation of traffic, lighting, sound and other required control measures during the drill will be fined between NT\$30,000 and NT\$150,000 in accordance with Article 25 of the Civil Defense Act.

The Emergency Alarm Sound Patterns:

1 long note and 2 short notes. The long note will last for 15 seconds, and the short notes, 5 second each. There will be an interval of 5 seconds between each note. They will be repeated for three times at a total of 115 seconds.

Sound Patterns for the Termination of Alarm:

1 long note of 90 seconds in length.
